9 DREAMY HOTELS FOR A LATE SUMMER GETAWAY IN SPAIN'S BALEARIC ISLANDS

Move over, July and August, September is officially the best time to visit Spain's Balearic Islands. Give the sweltering heat and overtourism of the peak summer months a miss and let September deliver a cooler vibe to the postcard-perfect Spanish islands of Mallorca, Menorca, Ibiza and Formentera.

Travel likely to continue with proof of vaccination
Although the U.S. was removed from the E.U.'s so-called "safe list" this week, the new restrictions are expected only to apply to unvaccinated visitors. Non-essential travel to Spain is still likely to be permitted for U.S. travelers who have been fully vaccinated with an E.U.-approved vaccine (Johnson & Johnson, Pfizer and Moderna all qualify), although they may be required to demonstrate a negative PCR test in addition to proof of vaccination.

CAN BORDOY

Stately Can Bordoy is nestled in the historic center of Palma, set in a 16th-century building that has been lovingly restored and renovated. The building, which feels more like a fairytale private palace than a hotel, consists of 24 suites, a lush verdant garden, a plant-forward restaurant, a secluded, heated swimming pool, and a rooftop with sweeping views of the old town, from where you can watch the swallows at dusk as the sun sets over the city. As if that wasn't enough, Can Bordoy also has a sensuous subterranean spa tucked between its XII-century walls.
